




## Fund raising

Over the last few years, membership has topped 100 and new members are always welcome.


Membership fees are \$10.00 p.a.

**B**undanoon History Group was formed by interested local residents in the early 1980s and has met monthly since 1984.

Its primary objectives are to research and preserve the early history of Bundanoon and the surrounding district and to promote interest in our local history.

Since then enthusiastic members have amassed an extensive collection of written and photographic material, which is available for inspection and research.

The acquisition of the historic Old Goods Shed at Bundanoon railway station in 1994 was a major step in the development of the Group – providing a venue where this material can be housed and appropriately displayed.



### Local history displays

Our displays, which change regularly, highlight aspects of life in Bundanoon from early days to the present.

The Old Goods Shed display area is open every market day (1st and 3rd Sundays of each month), or by appointment.



### Research

Members are encouraged to assist with research and archiving of material, but there is no obligation to do so.

A recent initiative is the collection of recorded oral histories involving long-term residents of the village.

We have an honorary archivist, who oversees the collection and researches queries from members of the public.

Information and photographs relating to Bundanoon are always welcomed.

### Outings

Twice a year, the Group organises trips (by coach or self drive) to places of historical interest. These are usually day excursions, although overnight trips are envisaged.

These trips extend our knowledge of the history of the local area and provide members and guests with an interesting and enjoyable outing.
