

Over the years, enthusiastic members have undertaken all manner of projects to help fulfil these objectives and there is now an extensive collection of written and photographic material available in the archives.

The acquisition of the Old Goods Shed in 1994 was a major step in the development of the Group – the gathered material is now able to be housed (and displayed) in one place.

Local history displays

Our displays, which change regularly, highlight aspects of life in Bundanoon from early days to the present.

The Old Goods Shed display area is open every market day (1st and 3rd Sundays of each month), or by appointment.



Research

All members are encouraged to assist with research and archiving of material, but there is no obligation to do so.

A recently started project is the collection of recorded oral histories involving long-term residents of the village.

There is an honorary archivist, who oversees the collection and researches queries from members of the public.

Donated information and photographs relating to Bundanoon are always welcomed.

Outings

Normally twice a year, the Group organises trips (by coach or self drive) to places of historical interest in the surrounding area. These are most often day excursions, although overnight trips are possible.

These trips extend our knowledge of the history of the local area and provide members and visitors with an interesting and fun outing.



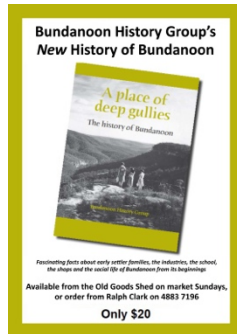
Fund raising

Over the last few years, membership has topped 100 and new members are always welcome.

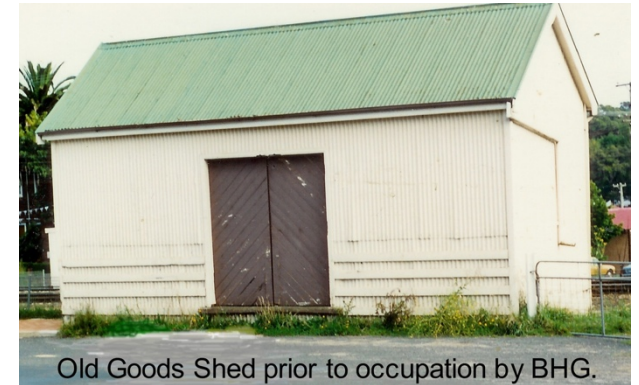
Membership fees are \$10.00 p. p. annually.
